Summary/Objective:

This position is responsible for managing all aspects of the total educational program of assigned students placed in Hilltop Home's certified non-public school. The special education teacher is responsible for performing educational assessment and evaluation of students, developing and reviewing Individual Education Programs, developing and carrying out appropriate educational activities, and performing regular progress reviews of student educational goals and objectives. The special education teacher is also responsible for supervising teaching assistants. The special education teacher assures that all North Carolina Department of Public Instruction standards and regulations are met on a consistent basis, while providing the highest quality of educational programming.

Classroom Environment:

1. Maintain clean, attractive, developmentally-appropriate classroom setting.
2. Ensure consistent, structured daily schedule of educational activities.
3. Maintain appropriate level of sensory input in classroom setting. Ensure stimulating environment while respecting individual sensory integration needs of students (noise level, room lighting, etc.).
4. Maintain learning materials in efficient, organized manner and monitor inventory of materials on a regular basis.
5. Maintain learning materials, including computers, in proper working condition.
6. Maintain attractive, decorative bulletin boards that are changed out on seasonal basis.
